### Excerpts from the Constitution, Article V, Section 4

All nominations for membership must be submitted to the Secretary of the club in writing and must state the academic degree or distinction of the candidate and the candidate's accomplishments in business, professional and civic affairs. Each nomination must be signed by not less than three active or life members not more than two of which shall be on the membership committee, and who shall be designated as sponsors. A nomination may be initiated at any time by any active or life member. At the first regular meeting after the filing of any nomination, it shall be read to the membership by the Secretary and the matter shall then be considered officially before the membership committee. It is expected that any member or members having objections will make them known, either by oral statement to any committee member, or in writing. The committee shall then make an investigation of the candidate's qualifications and of members' objections in such manner as a majority of the committee shall deem wise. By a majority vote of not less than seven members of the committee, an application shall be considered "approved." Names approved shall be placed on the eligible list in their proper classification -town or campus- and report made at the next regular meeting of the club. From this list, names shall be submitted for final election by the membership and acted upon in the order in which presented by the committee as vacancies occur, but in cases final action shall not have been taken on any recommended name within two years, the sponsors shall be notified that the name will not receive further consideration unless it is resubmitted. A two-thirds vote of the members present and voting at any regular business meeting of the club shall be sufficient to ratify the recommendation of the membership committee and shall constitute election to the club. Voting shall be by secret ballot on each name separately and not otherwise, and the result shall be announced without figures. The President shall inform new members of their acceptance to membership and the Treasurer informs them of their prorated dues.
